# 01 Installation - Unboxing


### 01 Installation











#### Setup DASH Instrument

- Prepare a dry level surface for the DASH Instrument and accessories
- 2. Locate the two shipment boxes
  - DASH Instrument
  - DASH Instrument Accessories
- 3. Unbox the DASH Instrument
- 4. Unbox accessories
  - Printer
  - Barcode Scanner
  - Required cords

# 02 DASH Instrument Installation

### 02 Installation

#### Setup DASH Instrument

- Place DASH Instrument with back side facing you
- 6. Connect power cord to DASH Instrument before plugging into outlet
  - Use cord with XP Power logo, flat side of plug facing up
- 7. Connect USB cords for barcode scanner and printer
- 8. Turn printer upside down for easier access to connect USB and power cord

#### Setup DASH Instrument

- 8. Turn printer upside down for easier access to connect USB and power cord
- 9. Place thermal paper roll in printer & tear off excess
- 10. Connect cord into scanner, bending the scanner as needed for easier access.

# 05 Powering on the DASH

## 05 Powering on the DASH



#### Setup DASH Instrument

- 11. Power on DASH Instrument and printer
- 12. Push "Eject Cartridge" button when it comes up on the graphical user interface (GUI)
- 13. Remove shipping Cartridge from carrier and **RETAIN**
- Shipping Cartridge to be used for transport

**NOTE:** Prior to use, inspect system materials for damage (e.g., cracked screen, frayed wiring, etc.). DO NOT use if system materials are damaged


# 06 DASH Instrument Log-in

## 06 DASH Instrument Log-in

#### User Log-in

- 1. After DASH Instrument warm-up, the username menu will appear
- 2. Designated administrator will select "GenAdmin" and use the pre-set PIN: 00000

**NOTE:** If cloud connectivity is not chosen, the DASH Instrument will only be used via a GenAdmin login without individual operators; skip to "Running QC Samples" section.



# 07 Connection to Internet

## 07 DASH Instrument Log-in

#### Internet Connection is Required for Portal

- Wi-Fi Connection:
  - 1. After initial log-in, tap on "Settings" on the DASH Instrument
  - 2. Tap "Wi-Fi Configuration" and "Enable Wi-Fi"
    - You should see the Wi-Fi sources displayed
  - 3. Choose the Wi-Fi source and tap "Configure"
  - 4. Enter the password and tap "Connect"
    - Once connected, you should see the blue "F" at the bottom of the GUI



If ethernet connection is preferred:
